# 国際コミュニケーションコース 総合型選抜

## 第1問

英語学習を助ける技術についての自らの考えを、他者に対してわかりやすく英語で伝える力を問う問題。求められていることに的確に答える内容となっているか、アウトラインがわかりやすいか、スペルミスや文法の誤りがないか、英語の表現力があるかを採点の基準とする。

#### 模範解答

# 模範解答

Misunderstanding can be caused by several factors. One is the lack of clear language on the side of the speaker. Messages should be spoken clearly with precise words so the listener can understand what the speaker means. However, it is common for speakers to use vague words when they cannot find the best language to describe what they mean. In other cases, the speaker may share too much or too little information. If that happens, the listener must guess what the speaker means, or imagine what information is important. Another cause of misunderstanding is the poor understanding on the side of the listener. Not everyone is a good listener. People have different levels of listening abilities. Some listeners may be interested and highly motivated to understand what the speaker says, but others may be bored, sleepy, or uninterested. Such listeners may not understand the message correctly.
